

PARENT FACT SHEET

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1) **Can I request a particular coach or team?**

Special requests are accepted, but **NOT GUARANTEED**. Our staff will make every effort to honor all requests; however, due to the popularity of the league not all requests can be honored.

2) **Where do I go to register my child for a Youth Sport program?**

Registrations are accepted at the Community and Recreation Services Administration offices located at 15960 N. Bullard Avenue, Monday through Friday from 8am-5pm. Special Saturday registrations are held for each program on the final two Saturdays of the registration period. Cash, check and Visa/Mastercard are accepted at the Administration offices. Please include a copy of the participant's birth certificate with mail-in registrations.

3) **Do you need volunteer coaches?**

YES! We are always recruiting volunteer head coaches and assistant coaches. All coaches are required to be finger printed and complete a Volunteer Application. Please contact the youth sports division at the Community and Recreation Services office at 623.222.2000 for more information.

4) **What do I do if I missed the registration deadline?**

If you miss the deadline for registration, you may still register your child under the following conditions:

- A) Roster openings exist in the age division your child will play in.
- B) A \$10 Late Fee is charged to the registration fee.

5) **Who will contact my child for practice?**

The volunteer coach will contact your child after the coach's meeting. The head coach will decide practice times and locations and all efforts will be made to make it convenient for all involved.

7) **What happens if I withdraw my child from the program?**

The Community and Recreation Services Department will issue credits in the event of withdrawal from a program, if the withdrawal is before the season begins. Credits for withdrawals after the start of the season are on a case by case instance.

8) **Can my child play in a division in which he/she does not meet the age requirements?**

Consideration will be given for all requests for participants to play in a division that they do not meet the age requirements. All requests must first be approved by City of Surprise staff and will require the child's parent/guardian to sign a Waiver, which states that they understand that if for any reason their child is deemed to not meet program criteria due to issues relating to safety and/or program function, he/she may be removed from that division.
