MEETING MINUTES

The Community Outreach Grants Program was reviewed. The Sub-committee also discussed possible refinements to the application process, criteria for evaluation proposals, and eligibility.

The initial amount of funds available for the 2013-14 fiscal year was \$50,000. In the first round, \$35,400 dollars were awarded, leaving a balance of \$14,600 to be awarded. Nine applications were received for the second round for a total of \$47,777. The Sub-committee discussed each of the applications.

Following discussion, the Sub-committee agreed to present the following recommendations to the City Council for approval based on their overall benefit to the City of Surprise:

West Valley Symphony—Poster art contest in conjunction with WHAM and Dysart students to increase visibility of the Symphony and its concerts. \$1,750.

St. Vincent de Paul Society—Utility assistance for twenty families in the City of Surprise. \$5,000.


Friends of Surprise Libraries—Awareness campaign for used book store located in the Library. \$ 240.

Rio Salado—Surprise Community Intergenerational Sustainability Program. \$4,110.

American Cancer Society/Relay for Life \$3,500.
