

Surprise City Court will resume in-person proceedings on Tuesday, June 2, 2020. Here is what you need to know before coming to the Courthouse.

All persons entering the courthouse will be required to wear a face mask/covering. The Court has a limited supply of face masks and may not be able to provide one for you, so it is important that you bring the mask/covering with you. Individuals who refuse to comply with the mask/covering requirement, will not be allowed to enter the courthouse and this may result in their court appearance being rescheduled.

In-person proceedings will be limited to parties, witnesses, court personnel, and any other necessary persons.

We are coordinating with state and county health departments and other governmental agencies to ensure we are consistent with their guidance in the appropriate response while fulfilling our statutory and constitutional obligations.
